

#### MEMORIAL HALL 1225 Elm St, Cincinnati, OH 45202

We are proud to announce our annual event will be held at the stunning Memorial Hall. Fully renovated in 2016, this gorgeous historic building was restored to its former elegance while allowing for modern upgrades that elevate both performer and audience experience. Memorial Hall features marble staircases adored with intricate wrought iron that lead to the 556-seat proscenium theater. Replete with exceptional acoustics, decorative murals, and Tiffany chandeliers, being on stage in this historic performance space will be a once-in-a-lifetime experience!

Competition will be at Memorial Hall Tuesday and Wednesday, July 25-26, and Friday and Saturday, July 28-29.

**Parking:** Hourly parking is available in the Washington Park underground garage located across the street from the venue. Rates and additional parking options can be found on Memorial Hall's website.

#### THE WESTIN CINCINNATI 21 E 5th St, Cincinnati, OH 45202

Overlooking the historic Fountain Square, our host hotel boasts an outstanding location in the heart of Cincinnati's bustling central business district and downtown's vast array of fine restaurants, shops, museums, theaters and celebrated sports stadiums. The Westin Cincinnati is just 0.8 miles in walking distance from Memorial Hall. A FREE streetcar (The Cincinnati Bell Connector) runs every 30 minutes daily between the Westin and Memorial Hall. The ride between the Fountain Square stop (near the Westin) and 14th & Elm stop (near Memorial Hall) takes approximately 30 minutes.

The room rate is \$149 per night + taxes. This is an incredible rate for this gorgeous hotel! - Payment Plans: After you pay your deposit, your remaining balance can be paid in monthly installments as low as \$50 per month. Any remaining balance on your entry fees, national t-shirt, and official program book will be due in full June 30, 2023.

# Required Events

#### Interview

- Personal interview will be panel-style where you will meet with all of the judges at the same time.
- Contestants in the 7-9 year old division will have a twominute interview. Contestants 10 years old and up will have a four-minute interview.
- There will be a total of 3-4 professional pageant judges in the room conducting your panel interview. This is the best way for the judges to get to know you on a personal level and really see your personality shine. The judges want to see the real you, do not rehearse your answers; the judges can tell if you are not being real.
- Questions are based on the interview resume you submit (see page 10).
- Your outfit should be something fresh, simple, and age appropriate. You may
  wear a business dress or a fashionable pantsuit. Traditional business suits are
  not necessary. Choose solid colors, and stay away from busy patterns and too
  much jewelry. Your shoes can be any color but preferably closed toe and simple.
  Remember that you are trying to achieve a polished, put-together look.





- Your personal introduction will be done on stage in your interview outfit (or a similar type outfit).
- You will have a total of 30 seconds to deliver your introduction. Judges will monitor and deduct points at their discretion if the 30 second time limit is exceeded.
- Your Introduction should contain your name, hometown and/ or state, and include one interesting fact about yourself.
   Above all strive to be real and let your personality shine!
- Introduction Example: I'm an enthusiastic 4th grader coming to you from My Town, USA! One day I plan to be the first female on Mars. When I'm not gazing at the sky, I'm at home playing with my new puppy and enjoying time with my family. Remember my name, Sarah Sue Smith, one day you will read about my journey to the stars!



## Required Events (cont.)

#### Formal Wear

- Each contestant will have their moment alone in the spotlight in the formal gown of her choice. You will have approximately 45 seconds on stage.
- Ages 7 years and up must wear a long formal gown.
- Small sweeps are allowed, provided the contestant is able to handle the train without tripping. A small slit is permitted in the age groups 16 years and up. Sexy dresses showing too much skin are discouraged in all age divisions. Sweetheart contestants should have straps on their gowns.
- Long formals should gently brush the ground, and at most be no more than 1" from the floor. Do not hold your gown while walking. Your formal should not puddle on the floor in the front, but should be long enough to cover your shoes.
- All gown colors are welcome, please choose your color to suit your complexion and personality.
- This will be your time to shine and display your grace on stage.
   Be sure to make eye contact with each judge and show them your beautiful smile.

#### Community Donation

- Our national goal is to partner with organizations that support and empower women. Every year we work tirelessly to seek out these amazing organizations. This year we are proud to announce that we will be parterning with not one, not two, but three different organizations!
- The three organizations will correspond with the three programs:
   Princess Program, National Program, and Excellence Elite Program.

   This will count as 10% of your score. All delegates are required to donate at least one item to receive their full 10%. See below for donation lists. All contestants must submit a typed list of items at registration and make sure your donations are packaged for easy transport.
- The Excellence Elite Program delegates will be gathering donations for the Ronald McDonald House. Cincinnati's Ronald McDonald House provides a home for critically ill children and their families while they get the life-saving medical care they need. Please find the donation list for Ronald McDonald House on the next page.
- Delegates interested in running for the **National Community Service Queen** should focus on putting your heart and your time into collecting donations for your assigned charity. You will also be required to submit a brief essay of no more than 500 words expressing what our motto, "Crown to Serve," means to you. The essay should also briefly describe your community service activities and what you collected for your charity and why. Participants ages 0-6 are allowed to have adult assistance with their essay.
- We will be crowning **3 National Community Service Queens**, one for each competition group: Princess, National, and Excellence Elite.

Your Interview Resume Form is very simple to fill out; there are no "trick" questions and there are no right or wrong answers. Your resume is all about you. Just answer truthfully - it's that easy!

Please note that the resume is only one sheet. **Do not exceed one sheet**, your resume is only an outline of your activities and should not include details. Many of you will have more information than you can fit on the page, in these cases, please do your best to condense your activities to fit the space provided.

Your resume will be used as a starting point for conversation during your interview. Think of your interview as if you were applying for the job of Queen, ultimately the judges will want to know why you want the position of American Royal Beauties National or National Excellence Queen.



Good paperwork is a concise guide; use it to guide the judges to the subjects you really want to talk about during your interview. The time to elaborate is during interview, not on your resume.



you. Make sure you seize this chance to impress them! Your resume should look professional and contain recent relevant details and accomplishments that you can easily talk about. Never put a detail on your resume that you cannot fully discuss.



your resume triple check! Once you hit the submit button, you can't take it back. Get another set of eyes on your paperwork before you turn it in; fresh eyes can sometimes catch mistakes you may have overlooked. You don't want to give the judges any reason to think anything negative about you before they've had a chance to talk to you.

#### **Talent**

- The time limit for talent is 2.5 minutes.
- Age appropriate makeup, outfits, and hand-held props are allowed. No backdrops.
- Music must be family friendly no explicit content.

- Come ready to enjoy the sisterhood! Dancing, PJ Contests, and Door Prizes await you at this fun-filled welcome event for the entire family.



#### Glitter Party

- Delegates ages 7 and up (and their families) will attend a fun-filled evening at our fabulous Glitter Party.
- Attire will be your National t-shirt, your choice of bottoms and shoes, your crown and sash, and any type of glitter accessory.
- You will be taking group photos by division at the party and exchanging gifts with your sister queens.
- No loose glitter is permitted. Any glitter adornments on your outfits should not transfer to the theater seats or fall out onto the floor.





**GIFT EXCHANGE!** Bring two wrapped gifts to the party for a fun fast-paced gift swap! The gifts should be inexpensive and age appropriate for your assigned group (you are not required to bring gifts for your entire division): ages 0-6 years, 7-18 years, and 19 years & up.



#### **ACTIVITIES & PARTIES**

**Registration** - Casual Attire (short set, romper, sundress or the like)

Pink & Purple Welcome Party - Casual/PJ Attire (pink and/or purple - creativity encouraged)

#### **REQUIRED EVENTS**

Please see the description of each required event in the preceeding pages for more specific guidelines and rules for competition.

**Formal Wear** - Choose the color of your gown to suit your complexion and personality - your gown should also be age appropriate. The dress should gently brush the ground, and at most be no more than 1" from the floor for ages 7 & up. Trains are allowed providing the contestant can walk easily.

**Interview / Introduction** - Business dress or pantsuit - bright solid colors recommended and avoid busy patterns. Shoes can be any color, but preferably closed-toe and simple. Panty hose are not required.

#### **OPTIONAL EVENTS**

**Casual Wear** - An outfit right out of your closet or off the rack (e.g., sundresses, rompers, jeans with a cute top, etc). Please *no costumes*, swimwear, or sportswear.

**Runway** - Think red carpet runway for this competition (e.g., cocktail dresses, hi-low outfits, fashionable jumpers and pantsuits). No costumes or long formal gowns.

Spokesmodel / Talent / Pairs Modeling - Choose your own outfit based on your routine or performance.

Optional Awards Ceremony - Red Carpet attire, no formals

#### **ADS PAY YOUR WAY TO NATIONALS!**

- Our ad program is simple: for every ad you sell, half of the money will be applied to your fees.
- That's not all! For every **10 full ad pages** you sell, you will receive **one night paid** at the host hotel!
- The contestant that **sells the most ads** will receive a stunning crown and award on stage at Nationals.





The American Royal Beauties Ad program is one of the best in the pageant world! There is no requirement to even sell ads, but if you do there is such a reward. Every year, Delegates are able to pay their entire fees using the ad program. Although it may seem daunting, there is real success available if you are willing to put yourself out into your community.

When I competed, I thought I would try to sell a couple ads to save some money on my National fees, but I was so surprised by the success I had! By the time Nationals came, I had my entire entry fee paid, including my optional entry fees! Also, winning a night paid at the host hotel helped to make Nationals super affordable! Here are a few helpful tips I'd recommend:

- Just go for it! The worst that can happen is someone saying "no thank you," but at least you tried!
- ▼ Start small. Reach out to close friends and family members. From what I've seen, those close to you are typically the most willing to help
- Reach out to local small businesses. I'd suggest ones you've shopped with or that you've gained some sort of relationship with. Don't count out your friends' businesses as well! My friends were happy to support me and advertise their business at the same time.
- ▼ It's okay to follow up! If you shoot an email or text to someone and you haven't heard back in 7-10 days, try again!
- It's important to keep asking! You will be surprised by who says yes to you! Don't get discouraged with rejection and keep trying with new people.





## Tell Sponsor Ads

- ♥ Visit your family, friends, and other prospects. Who are "other prospects?" These are people you have supported over the years, they know you, and they are happy to return your support. Ads are tax-deductible as an advertising expense. Be sure to provide a receipt!
- ♥ Examples include dentists, doctors, vets, insurance agents, restaurants, salon, etc. These local business people have the authority and funds set aside to advertise and to show support. But don't forget your family, they will want to cheer you on with an ad too!!!
- ♥ Sponsor Ads can be purchased in blocks of any size. However, it us up to you to compile your ads into one full 8.5x11" page. Each full page submission is \$100.

## Nesign Your Ad Pages

- ▼ Ads must be submitted in fully designed format. You are responsible for compiling all of the ads you sell into a full-page layout. You can do so yourself in a word processing software, an online software like Canva, or by partnering with a professional graphic artist to complete your designs.
- ♥ Please submit high-resolution ad layouts and don't put any text within 0.75" of the edges.
- ♥ Ads will be printed in full color and may be submitted as grayscale or color images.
- ▼ Layouts can be created in whatever way you would like, as long as the ads add up to complete full page submissions. An example ad page layout is shown on the next page, but you are free to arrange your ads however you would like based on the blocks you have sold.

#### **BASIC COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS**

You must be a resident of or have an affiliation with the state you want to represent. American Royal Beauties is a national scholarship system open to girls and women of all ages in every state in the USA, Canada, and Puerto Rico. Contestants must be biologically female.

#### **AGE DIVISIONS**

Little Miss 7-10 yrs Junior Miss 11-13 yrs Young Miss 14-17 yrs Modern Ms. 18-34 yrs\* Classic Ms. 35+ yrs\* \*married or unmarried

Your age division is determined by your age and marital status on January 1 of the year of the National pageant. The director reserves the right to move a contestant up or down one age division to accommodate a contestant's individual circumstances. Each situation will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis at the director's discretion. If a contestant falls within 30 days of aging up to the next division, the contestant can elect to stay in the younger age division at state and continue in that age division for nationals.

Contestants in all categories, except for the Modern Ms. and Classic Ms. divisions, must be unmarried. Contestants can be married or unmarried in the Modern Ms. and Classic Ms. divisions.

Optional awards and side awards may combine age divisions if there are not enough contestants participating. In order to award for a single age division, there needs to be a minimum of five contestants participating in the optional or side competition. Age divisions will be combined for awards according to the director's discretion. The main queen title will never be combined, and will be given for each age division.

#### **MAKEUP & OUTFIT GUIDELINES**

Baby, Tiny, Princess age divisions are not allowed to wear makeup. Contestants in our Little Miss age division are allowed minimal makeup consisting of lip gloss, light mascara, and pressed powder for shine only; some concealer is okay if needed. Junior Miss and older Age Divisions are allowed age appropriate makeup, but not overdone. We are a natural pageant, we want to see the natural you shine through. Contestants may not wear flippers or wigs, unless there is a medical reason or it is a part of their normal every day look. Hair extensions and weaves are allowed in the Young Miss age divisions and above. Spray tans are allowed in all Excellence Elite divisions as long as they look natural; please no orange or dark tans. Spray tans should be used to even out complexions and add a natural glow only.

We are a family friendly competition, please only age appropriate outfits. Anything revealing or sexy is absolutely not allowed. No contestant can wear gowns or outfits with upper thigh-high slits, cutouts showing too much skin, mini-skirts, or deep plunging necklines revealing too much cleavage. Strapless gowns are allowed in the Pre-Teen and above divisions. Contestants in the Young Miss and above divisions are allowed to have a modest slit in their gown. Two-piece gowns and gowns with cutouts are allowed as long as they are modest and sophisticated, and not sexy or too revealing.

Costumes used for talent optionals must be age appropriate and family friendly. Anything overtly vulgar or sexually explicit will not be allowed. All music must be family friendly.

Any makeup or outfit violation will result in an automatic point deduction. In extreme cases the Directors may choose to not allow the contestant to compete until the violation is corrected.

#### **SASH PROTOCOL**

The sash is worn on your right shoulder and attaches at your left hip. State and local titleholders are not permitted to add rhinestones to their sash; this designation is reserved for national royalty. State and local titleholders can add their first name only to the back of their sash with a script or block font. Your name will be read left to right and should be embroidered UP the back of your sash. You are permitted to add five sash pins/buttons maximum on your sash, as long as the items do not detract or cover any of the embroidery on your sash. Pins/buttons representing other pageant systems are not permitted on your sash.



#### **SCORES, COMMENTS, & RANKING**

Scores and comments are emailed within 4-6 weeks following an event. Comments are transcribed for an additional fee. Please see the National Delegate Facebook group for additional details. American Royal Beauties does not disclose overall ranking, and will only announce runner-ups as long as there are a minimum of two remaining contestants on-stage. We will not leave one competitor formally announced in last place.

#### **APPEARANCES**

State Queens are required to complete 7 quality appearances and return to state to crown your successor. National Queens are required to complete 12 quality appearances (one a month) and return to nationals to crown their successor. National Princess Program Queens are required to complete 8 quality appearances. The definition of a quality appearance is that you are actively promoting the system by either performing community service, passing out cards or flyers, speaking in public about the system, or engaging in recruiting contestants in some way. Any other type of appearance will not count towards your required appearances. We consider the main job of our queens is to be the ambassadors for our system and actively engage in the pursuit of promoting their titles and the system. We encourage combining community service with actively promoting the system; such as speaking about your title at a fundraiser for charity. Please note, a quality appearance takes time and cannot be accomplished by taking a picture in front of a building and passing out a couple of flyers. Each appearance should take time and thoughtful preparation. All appearances must be submitted to the national office (via the appearance form) and posted on your social media account within 30 days of the appearance.

Do not make an appearance at another pageant system and try to recruit contestants, that is considered rude and frowned upon by everyone in the pageant community. This is not considered a quality appearance unless the director of that system allows you to announce your title on stage (or be recognized in some way), wear your crown and sash, and pass out cards (only if you are approached - never actively recruit contestants at another pageant system). Always be respectful of other pageant systems, and contact the director before attending to ask about their particular rules; for instance, can you wear both your crown and sash, or is it sash only, can you hand out an autograph card if you are approached, etc. If you are judging the pageant and the director of that pageant allows you to talk a little about your title and/or write about your title in your judge's bio that would be considered a quality appearance.

#### **NON-COMPETE CLAUSE**

State and local titleholders do not have a no-compete clause. However, while you hold a state or local title with American Royal Beauties, you are not permitted to compete in another pageant system that does have a no-compete clause.

National Queens (ages 0-6) do not have a no-compete clause. However, National Queens (ages 7 & up) DO HAVE a no-compete clause. It is a privilege and honor to represent American Royal Beauties at the national level. All of our contestants work extremely hard to represent American Royal Beauties and their platforms. All National titleholders are required to place their national title as their first priority throughout their year of reign. Always check with the director first to make sure your other titles will not interfere with your national title.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

Bad sportsmanship and gossip will not be tolerated and are cause for disqualification during a competition, and in extreme cases the loss of your title if you are a reigning queen. We take this very seriously and have zero tolerance for inappropriate behavior of any kind. Any contestant that is disqualified or reigning queen that has her title revoked for this reason will be banned from competition for a period of one year, a second incident will result in permanently being banned from competition.

All deposits and fees are non-refundable. All payments will have an administrative fee of approximately 3.5% attached to the final invoice.
