## WHAT IS A CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER?

- **Child-friendly locations where members of the multidisciplinary investigative team (MDIT), consisting of child welfare personnel, law enforcement officials, medical and mental professionals, prosecution and victim advocates meet to coordinate a response to allegations of child abuse, including child sexual abuse and child physical abuse.**
- **Designed to focus first on the needs of child victims and their non-offending caregivers throughout the investigation and intervention process. By doing so, the overall stress experienced by child victims is reduced and overall the quality of investigations are improved.**
- **Connect child victims and their family members to services including medical examinations, community mental health services, victim advocacy and other services as determined necessary, on a case-by-case basis.**
