National Checklist

- **REGISTER FOR NATIONALS** and pay your \$150 deposit within 30 days of receiving your title. The \$150 deposit ensures your National fees remain discounted. If your deposit is not received in time, your National fees will increase. Please submit your registration and deposit at this link: [National Registration Form](#). If you are applying for an Appointed Title use this link: [Appointed Title Application](#).
- **IMPORTANT!** Contestants who competed live at a state event, if you are unable to pay the deposit within the 30 days, please contact the office right away to preserve your winning discount. We are happy to work with you on a payment plan that will fit your budget. Although, we are unable to preserve the 40% or 30% discount past the deadline, we are able to preserve the 20% discount if you communicate with the office before the deadline.
- **PAYMENT PLANS** After you pay your deposit, your remaining balance can be paid in monthly installments as low as \$50 per month. 50% of your National entry fee is due by April 30, 2026. Any remaining balance on your entry fee, program book, or National T-shirt will be due in full by June 1, 2026. Any remaining balance on optional fees* is due by July 15, 2026.

*Print Model optional fees and Ad Program payments (if applicable) are due by June 1, 2026.

- **NATIONAL ENTRY FEE BREAKDOWN**

- **State and Local Winners** (7+ yrs): \$950 National fees include registration fee and entry fee for the formal wear competition, introduction competition, and interview. Side awards are FREE.
- **Optionals for Nationals** (\$60 each): Casual Wear, Runway, Photogenic, Print Model, Royal Portrait, Talent, Spokesmodel, Achievement, Platform Video, Fitness, and Pairs Modeling (\$30 per participant).
- **North American Royal Beauties titles** (additional \$75 entry fee): There are five North American Royal Beauties titles for ages 7+ available at Nationals. Those opting for these titles will be considered after the ARB National Queen winners are tabulated. Click [here](#) for more details.

- **HEADSHOT RESUBMISSIONS:** If you would like to use a different headshot than what you submitted on your registration form, please submit your new headshot [at this link](#). The most recently submitted headshot on file will be used for the program book. Final headshots must be submitted by June 1, 2026.
- **ENHANCE YOUR NATIONAL EXPERIENCE!** Optional competitions give you more chances for National Titles. Our Optional Winners are considered part of our reigning National Royalty. All of our optionals are reasonably priced and can be paid online at any time. Optionals can be entered more than once. All optional entries must be finalized by June 1, 2026. After this deadline, no changes can be made.
- **PAYMENT DEADLINE:** All payments are due in full by July 15, 2026.




ADDITIONAL TITLE OPT-IN

North American Royal Beauties

Five incredible ladies will become our National North American Royal Beauties titleholders. We feel strongly about our mission to serve our communities, and we are excited that five more ladies will have the chance to be Crowned to Serve on the National level.

It's easy to participate, just check the "add-on" box on your National registration to let us know that you want to be considered for the North American Royal Beauties National titles. If you've already submitted your registration form, email us at info@ARBpageants.com to have this added to your account.

The Details

- This title is not double-crowned. Winners of the National American Royal Beauties titles will not be considered for these titles.
- This is an opportunity for anyone wishing to have an additional chance at representing American Royal Beauties and the Crown to Serve mission at the National Level should you not win the National ARB title in your division.
- This opportunity is for ages 7 and up and requires an additional entry fee of \$75.
- All required event scores **PLUS** the contestant's single highest scoring on-stage optional will be tallied together to determine the winner in each division. These results will be tallied after the National American Royal Beauties title winners have been determined.
- Opting in to these titles has no bearing on the winners of the National American Royal Beauties title competition.
- Winners are contractually obliged to perform one community service project monthly.
- Winners are allowed to hold titles with other pageant systems with permission from the ARB directors.
- Winners have the option to return to Nationals the following year to crown their successor and receive additional perks at Nationals when their National contract is fulfilled.
- **Want to maximize your chances?** If you shine on stage as a model, captivate as a passionate speaker, or have a talent...or two, this is your opportunity! Delegates may enter each on-stage optional contest a maximum of two times, and their highest on-stage optional score will be counted toward their North American Title score.

Required Events

Interview

- Personal interview will be panel-style where you will meet with all of the judges at the same time.
- Contestants in the 7-9 year old division will have a two-minute interview. Contestants 10 years old and up will have a four-minute interview.
- There will be a total of 3-4 professional pageant judges in the room conducting your panel interview. This is the best way for the judges to get to know you on a personal level and really see your personality shine. The judges want to see the real you, do not rehearse your answers; the judges can tell if you are not being real.
- Questions are based on the interview resume you submit ([see page 12](#)).
- Your outfit should be something fresh, simple, and age appropriate. You may wear a business dress or a fashionable pantsuit. Traditional business suits are not necessary. Choose solid colors, and stay away from busy patterns and too much jewelry. Your shoes can be any color but preferably closed toe and simple. Remember that you are trying to achieve a polished, put-together look.
- **NEW THIS YEAR** The delegate with the highest interview score in the entire pageant will win a sponsored item from Craft-n-Go!



Personal Introduction



- Your personal introduction will be done on stage in your interview outfit (or a similar type outfit).
- You will have a total of 30 seconds to deliver your introduction. Judges will monitor and deduct points at their discretion if the 30 second time limit is exceeded.
- Your Introduction should contain your name, hometown and/or state, and include one interesting fact about yourself. Above all strive to be real and let your personality shine!
- Introduction Example: I'm an enthusiastic 4th grader coming to you from My Town, USA! One day I plan to be the first female on Mars. When I'm not gazing at the sky, I'm at home playing with my new puppy and enjoying time with my family. Remember my name, Sarah Sue Smith, one day you will read about my journey to the stars!

Required Events (cont.)

Formal Wear

- Each contestant will have their moment alone in the spotlight in the formal gown of her choice. You will have approximately 45 seconds on stage.
- Ages 7 years and up must wear a long formal gown.
- Small sweeps are allowed, provided the contestant is able to handle the train without tripping. A small slit is permitted in the age groups 16 years and up. Sexy dresses showing too much skin are discouraged in all age divisions. Sweetheart contestants should have straps on their gowns.
- Long formals should gently brush the ground, and at most be no more than 1" from the floor. Do not hold your gown while walking. Your formal should not puddle on the floor in the front, but should be long enough to cover your shoes.
- All gown colors are welcome, please choose your color to suit your complexion and personality.
- This will be your time to shine and display your grace on stage. Be sure to make eye contact with each judge and show them your beautiful smile.



Community Donation



- Our National goal is to partner with organizations that support and empower women, children, and the local community. Every year we work tirelessly to seek out these amazing organizations. This year we are proud to announce that we will be partnering with two different organizations! Learn more about these organizations and the donations they need on the next page.
- The organizations will correspond with three age groups: ages 0-6, 7-18, and 19+. This will count as 10% of your score. All delegates are required to donate at least one item to receive their full 10%. Donations lists are provided on the next page. All contestants must submit a typed list and total count of items at registration and make sure your donations are packaged for easy transport.
- Alternatively, donations may be shipped directly to the organization. **Important:** If you ship donations, you must provide shipping proof and an itemized list of what was donated. Shipping addresses are provided on the next page.
- Community Service winners will receive an award in each division. This is presented to the delegate who brings the most donations for her age group's National charity.

National Charity

THE RUBY PROJECT

Period poverty is a quiet crisis. Nearly 1 in 4 teens miss school* because they don't have menstrual products, 36% of women miss work every month for the same reason. Through The Ruby Project, we respond with dignity, not shame. Discreet period care bags. Thoughtfully packed. Ready to be handed out with compassion.

This season, we're equipping all newly crowned State Queens with plans to expand nationwide, ensuring girls and women are supported wherever they are. Because there is no safety net for period care. When girls miss school, futures are interrupted. When women miss work, families feel it.

What we are doing:

- Active in 15 states
- 1,500 period bags distributed since October 2025
- Support for shelters, schools, sports teams, and communities
- Bags sent to Brazil
- Supplied an orphanage in Africa with supplies and translated our initiative into their native language
- Partnered with multiple pageant systems to advocate for girls and women nationwide

What's next:

- Expanding into more states
- Visiting our partnered orphanage in Africa this June
- Advocating to eliminate the Pink Tax
- Fighting for free menstrual products in schools, public institutions, and correctional facilities

Interview Resume

Your Interview Resume Form is very simple to fill out; there are no "trick" questions and there are no right or wrong answers. Your resume is all about you. Just answer truthfully - it's that easy!

Please note that the resume is only one sheet. **Do not exceed one sheet**, your resume is only an outline of your activities and should not include details. Many of you will have more information than you can fit on the page, in these cases, you must condense your activities to fit the space provided.

Your resume will be used as a starting point for conversation during your interview. Think of your interview as if you were applying for the job of Queen, ultimately the judges will want to know why you want the position of American Royal Beauties National Queen.

KEEP IT SIMPLE: Keep your resume brief. Save the good stuff for interview. Good paperwork is a concise guide; use it to guide the judges to the subjects you really want to talk about during your interview. The time to elaborate is during interview, not on your resume.

FIRST IMPRESSION: Your resume will be the first time the judges get to meet you. Make sure you seize this chance to impress them! Your resume should look professional and contain recent relevant details and accomplishments that you can easily talk about. Never put a detail on your resume that you cannot fully discuss.

DOUBLE CHECK: Always double check your paperwork, and in the case of your resume triple check! Once you hit the submit button, you can't take it back. Get another set of eyes on your paperwork before you turn it in; fresh eyes can sometimes catch mistakes you may have overlooked. You don't want to give the judges any reason to think anything negative about you before they've had a chance to talk to you.

- Well-prepared paperwork will be typed and utilize correct grammar, spelling and mechanics.

The Crown to Serve Excellence Award

This award recognizes valuable contributions of volunteers nationwide, who are serving others through current activities or lifetime service. To qualify, volunteers simply submit a record of their service hours to ARB, and we will verify the service and distribute the award.

Additionally, eligible volunteer service hours are not limited to those performed on behalf of ARB. Service hours can be accumulated through work on a variety of projects throughout the year. The hours must be completed between June 16, 2025 and June 15, 2026. All volunteers are responsible for tracking their own hours and submitting the appropriate documentation.

Service Award submissions and application are **due on June 15, 2026**. Submissions will be accepted June 1-June 15.

Our optional competitions are designed to showcase outstanding talents and strengths not included in the main competition. These competitions give you more chances at a National Title! Our optional winners are considered part of our National Royalty.

All optional events are open to all age divisions. Optional winners will be crowned on stage with a National Optional title. Optional competitions have no bearing on the main queen title. Optional winners can be double crowned. Optionals must be confirmed by June 1st. Photos can be entered multiple times; all other optionals may only be entered twice.

NATIONAL SPOKESMODEL: The highest Spokesmodel score will be used to determine the winner. This title will be awarded in all divisions ages 7 and up.

NATIONAL TOP MODEL: Casual Wear, Runway and Fitness scores will be used to determine the winner. You do not have to enter all three, this is not a combined score. The highest scoring optional wins. This title will be awarded in all divisions.

NATIONAL COVER GIRL: Print Model, Photogenic, and Royal Portrait scores will be used to determine the winner. You do not have to enter all three, this is not a combined score. The highest scoring optional wins. This title will be awarded in all divisions.

NATIONAL TALENT: The highest Talent score will be used to determine the winner. This title will be awarded in all divisions ages 7 and up.

NATIONAL ROLE MODEL: Achievement and Platform Video scores will be used to determine the winner. You do not have to enter both, this is not a combined score. The highest scoring optional wins. This title will be awarded in all divisions ages 7 and up.

NATIONAL COVER MODEL: The highest scoring Print Model entry in each program will be awarded the overall title. The American Royal Beauties Ad program is one of the best in the pageant world! There is no requirement to even sell ads, but if you do there is such a reward. Every year, Delegates are able to pay their entire fees using the ad program. Although it may seem daunting, there is real success available if you are willing to put yourself out into your community.

When I competed, I thought I would try to sell a couple ads to save some money on my National fees, but I was so surprised by the success I had! By the time Nationals came, I had my entire entry fee paid, including my optional entry fees! Also, winning a night paid at the host hotel helped to make Nationals super affordable! Here are a few helpful tips I'd recommend:

- ♥ **Just go for it!** The worst that can happen is someone saying "no thank you," but at least you tried!
- ♥ **Start small.** Reach out to close friends and family members. From what I've seen, those close to you are typically the most willing to help
- ♥ **Reach out to local small businesses.** I'd suggest ones you've shopped with or that you've gained some sort of relationship with. Don't count out your friends' businesses as well! My friends were happy to support me and advertise their business at the same time.
- ♥ **It's okay to follow up!** If you shoot an email or text to someone and you haven't heard back in 7-10 days, try again!
- ♥ **It's important to keep asking!** You will be surprised by who says yes to you! Don't get discouraged with rejection and keep trying with new people.

Sell Sponsor Ads

- ♥ Visit your family, friends, and other prospects. Who are "other prospects?" These are people you have supported over the years, they know you, and they are happy to return your support. **Ads are tax-deductible** as an advertising expense. Be sure to provide a receipt!
- ♥ Examples include dentists, doctors, vets, insurance agents, restaurants, salon, etc. These local business people have the authority and funds set aside to advertise and to show support. But don't forget your family, they will want to cheer you on with an ad too!!!
- ♥ Sponsor Ads can be purchased in blocks of any size. However, it is up to you to compile your ads into one full 8.5x11" page. Each full page submission is \$100.




You must be a resident of or have an affiliation with the state you want to represent. American Royal Beauties is a National scholarship system open to girls and women of all ages in every state in the USA, Canada, and Puerto Rico. Contestants must be biologically female.

Elegant Ms. 45 years and up (married or unmarried)
Mrs. 19 years and up (married)

Your age division is determined by your age and marital status on January 1 of the year of the National pageant. The director reserves the right to move a contestant up or down one age division to accommodate a contestant's individual circumstances. Each situation will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis at the director's discretion. If a contestant falls within 30 days of aging up to the next division, the contestant can elect to stay in the younger age division at state and continue in that age division for Nationals.

Contestants in all categories, except for the Mrs., Ms., & Elegant Ms. divisions, must be unmarried. Contestants can be married or unmarried in the Ms. and Elegant Ms. divisions. Contestants in the Mrs. division must be engaged or married by January 1 of the year of the National pageant. If you are engaged as of January 1 of the year of Nationals, then you must be married before the National pageant to compete for the Mrs. title.

Optional awards and side awards may combine age divisions if there are not enough contestants participating. In order to award for a single age division, there needs to be a minimum of five contestants participating in the optional or side competition. Age divisions will be combined for awards according to the director's discretion. The main queen title will never be combined, and will be given for each age division.

MAKEUP & OUTFIT GUIDELINES

These guidelines apply to all events, including stage events, interview, and photo submissions. Baby, Tiny, Princess age divisions are not allowed to wear makeup. Contestants in our Sweetheart age division are allowed minimal makeup consisting of lip gloss, light mascara, and pressed powder for shine only; some concealer is okay if needed. Pre-Teen and Older Age Divisions are allowed age appropriate makeup, but not overdone. We are a natural pageant, we want to see the natural you shine through. Contestants may not wear flippers or wigs, unless there is a medical reason or it is a part of their normal every day look. Hair extensions and weaves are allowed in the Jr. Teen age divisions and above. If you are in a younger division and wearing a hair extension or weave is a part of your everyday look, please email the National office, info@arbboxpageants.com. Spray tans are allowed in Sweetheart - Elegant Ms. divisions as long as they look natural; please no orange or dark tans. Spray tans should be used to even out complexions and add a natural glow only.

We are a family friendly competition, please only age appropriate outfits. Anything revealing or sexy is absolutely not allowed. No contestant can wear gowns or outfits with upper thigh-high slits, cutouts showing too much skin, mini-skirts, or deep plunging necklines revealing too much cleavage. Strapless gowns are allowed in the Pre-Teen and above divisions. Contestants in the Teen and above divisions are allowed to have a modest slit in their gown. Two-piece gowns and gowns with cutouts are allowed as long as they are modest and sophisticated, and not sexy or too revealing.

Costumes used for talent optionals must be age appropriate and family friendly. Anything overtly vulgar or sexually explicit will not be allowed. All music must be family friendly.

If a contestant is caught violating these guidelines the judges will be informed and points will be deducted for every event the contestant is in violation. In extreme cases of inappropriate outfits, the Directors may choose to not allow the contestant to compete until the violation is corrected.

PHOTO GUIDELINES

All photo entries should follow makeup and outfit rules listed above. Outfits and poses must be family friendly and age-appropriate. Light, natural retouching is allowed to enhance the image subtly (blemish removal, color correction, etc.). Photos should still resemble the contestant. Any post-processing should enhance the image without making it look overly manipulated or artificial. We do not allow AI (artificial intelligence) editing under any circumstances. This includes but is not limited to photos edited with the AI features of apps like FaceApp and FaceTune. Photos should be recognizable as the contestant. Absolutely no glitz photos (heavy makeup, extravagant hairstyles, or excessive retouching). Color or black-and-white photos are acceptable.

Rules

SASH PROTOCOL

The sash is worn on your right shoulder and attaches at your left hip. State and local titleholders are not permitted to add rhinestones to their sash; this designation is reserved for National royalty. State and local titleholders can add their first name only to the back of their sash with a script or block font. Your name will be read left to right and should be embroidered UP the back of your sash. You are permitted to add five sash pins/buttons maximum on your sash, as long as the items do not detract or cover any of the embroidery on your sash. Pins/buttons representing other pageant systems are not permitted on your sash.

SCORES, COMMENTS, & RANKING

Scores and comments are emailed within 4-6 weeks following an event. Comments are transcribed for an additional fee. Please see the National Delegate Facebook group for additional details. American Royal Beauties does not disclose overall ranking, and will only announce runner-ups as long as there are a minimum of two remaining contestants on-stage. We will not leave one competitor formally announced in last place.

APPEARANCES

State Queens are required to complete 7 quality appearances and return to state to crown your successor. National Queens are required to complete 12 quality appearances (one a month) and return to Nationals to crown their successor. National Princess Program Queens are required to complete 8 quality appearances. The definition of a quality appearance is that you are actively promoting the system by either performing community service, passing out cards or flyers, speaking in public about the system, or engaging in recruiting contestants in some way. Any other type of appearance will not count towards your required appearances. We consider the main job of our queens is to be the ambassadors for our system and actively engage in the pursuit of promoting their titles and the system. We encourage combining community service with actively promoting the system; such as speaking about your title at a fundraiser for charity. Please note, a quality appearance takes time and cannot be accomplished by taking a picture in front of a building and passing out a couple of flyers. Each appearance should take time and thoughtful preparation. All appearances must be submitted to the National office (via the appearance form) and posted on your social media account within 30 days of the appearance.

Do not make an appearance at another pageant system and try to recruit contestants, that is considered rude and frowned upon by everyone in the pageant community. This is not considered a quality appearance unless the director of that system allows you to announce your title on stage (or be recognized in some way), wear your crown and sash, and pass out cards (only if you are approached - never actively recruit contestants at another pageant system). Always be respectful of other pageant systems, and contact the director before attending to ask about their particular rules; for instance, can you wear both your crown and sash, or is it sash only, can you hand out an autograph card if you are approached, etc. If you are judging the pageant and the director of that pageant allows you to talk a little about your title and/or write about your title in your judge's bio that would be considered a quality appearance.

NON-COMPETE CLAUSE

Local, State, and North American titleholders do not have a no-compete clause. However, while you hold this title with American Royal Beauties, you are not permitted to compete in another pageant system that does have a no-compete clause.

National Queens (ages 0-6) do not have a no-compete clause. However, National Queens (ages 7 & up) DO HAVE a no-compete clause. It is a privilege and honor to represent American Royal Beauties at the National level. All of our contestants work extremely hard to represent American Royal Beauties and their platforms. All National titleholders are required to place their National title as their first priority throughout their year of reign. Always check with the director first to make sure your other titles will not interfere with your National title.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Bad sportsmanship and gossip will not be tolerated and are cause for disqualification during a competition, and in extreme cases the loss of your title if you are a reigning queen. We take this very seriously and have zero tolerance for inappropriate behavior of any kind. Any contestant that is disqualified or reigning queen that has her title revoked for this reason will be banned from competition for a period of one year, a second incident will result in permanently being banned from competition.

Participants and their guests shall not disparage ARB, its associated events, or any fellow contestants, through any means, including but not limited to, oral, written, or social media platforms. Engaging in disparagement will lead to the automatic forfeiture of titles and prizes.

All deposits and fees are non-refundable. All payments will have an administrative fee of approximately 3.5% attached to the final invoice.
